


Automatic Transmission (if equipped)

Downshifting increases power going uphill, or provides engine braking downhill. For best fuel economy during normal driving conditions, always drive with the shift lever in the "D" position.














By inserting an iPod customer cable connector into the iPod jack, you can charge the iPod battery and listen to music from your iPod through the vehicle's speaker system.


If belt is fully extended, then retracted even slightly, it cannot be re-extended beyond that point, unless fully retracted again. This feature is used to help hold child restraint systems securely.

To find more information about seat belts, and how to install a child restraint system, refer to the *Owner's Manual*.



If tire pressure becomes critically low on any of the tires (excluding spare), indicator comes on. Pushing " 💬 SET" button should not turn off the light. Correctly adjusting tire inflation will turn off the light after a few minutes. After replacing/rotating tire or wheels, the system must be initialized.
