CAUTION

When the Anti-lock Brake System (ABS) function is in action, you may feel the brake pedal pulsating and hear a noise. In this situation, to let the Anti-lock Brake System work for you, just hold the brake pedal down more firmly. Do not pump the brake as this will result in reduced braking performance.

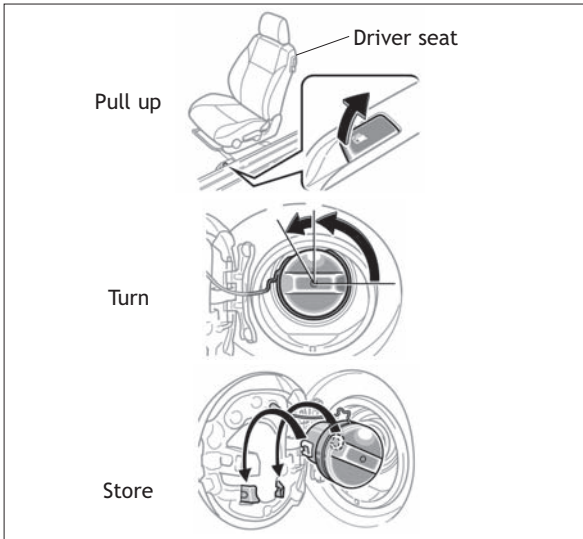

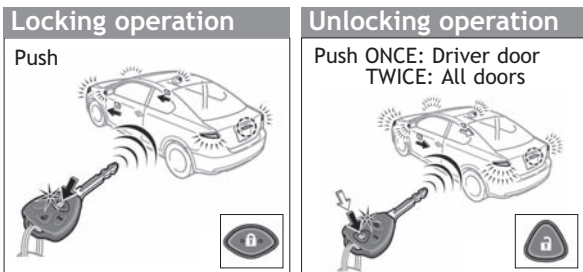

Keyless entry

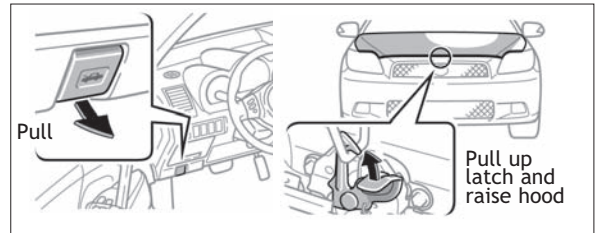


NOTE: After unlocking, if a door is not opened within thirty (30) seconds, all doors will relock for safety.

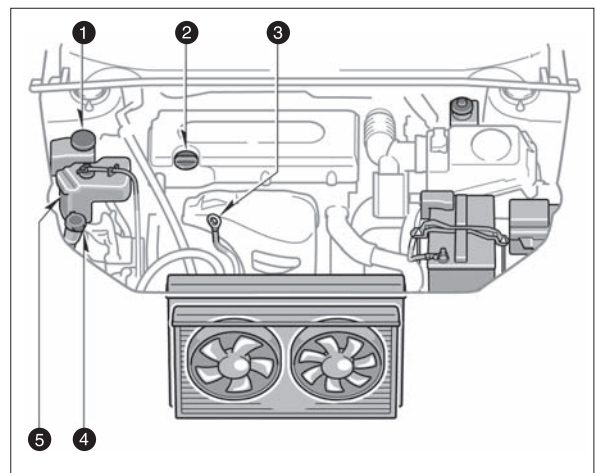

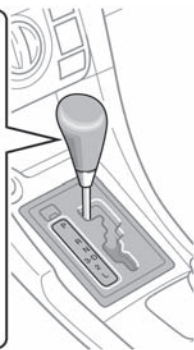
- 1 Power steering fluid reservoir

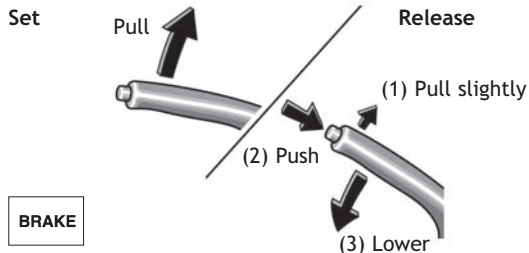
- P** Park¹

- L** First gear



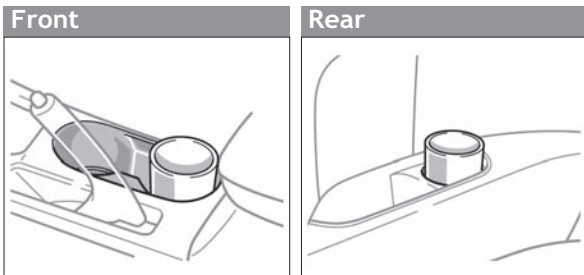
¹The ignition switch must be ON, and the brake pedal depressed to shift from "Park."

Downshifting increases power going uphill, or provides engine braking downhill. For best fuel economy during normal driving conditions, always drive with the shift lever in the "D" position.

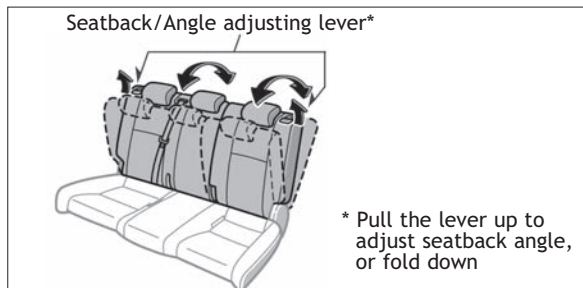

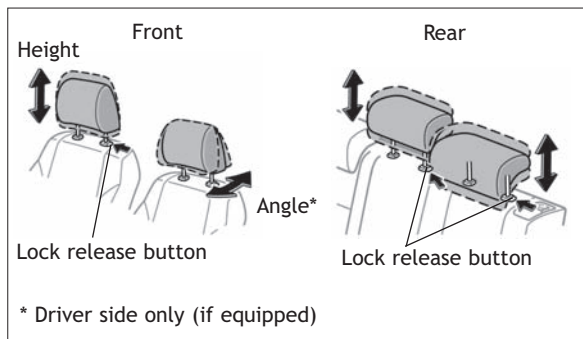


- ① Position

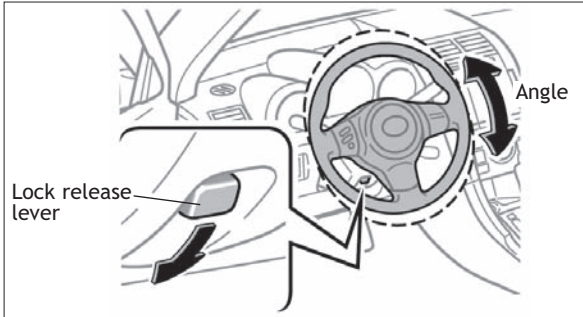

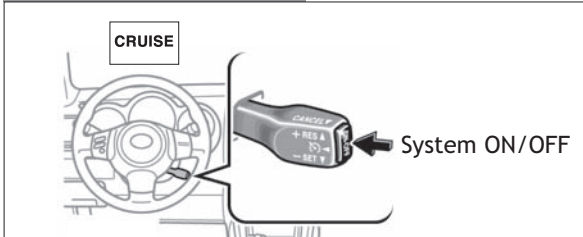


Hold wheel, push lever down, set angle, then return lever.

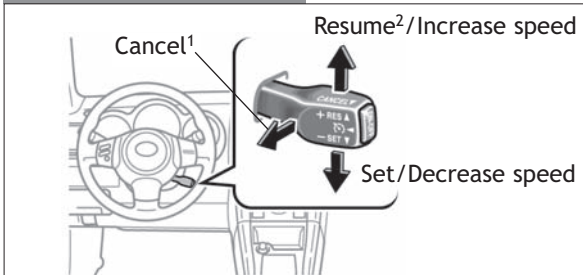

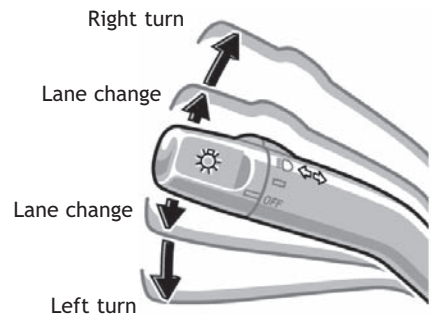

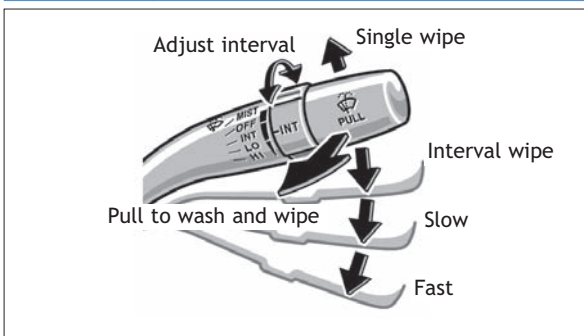
High beam flasher

Automatic light cutoff system Automatically turns lights off when driver's door is opened with the engine off.

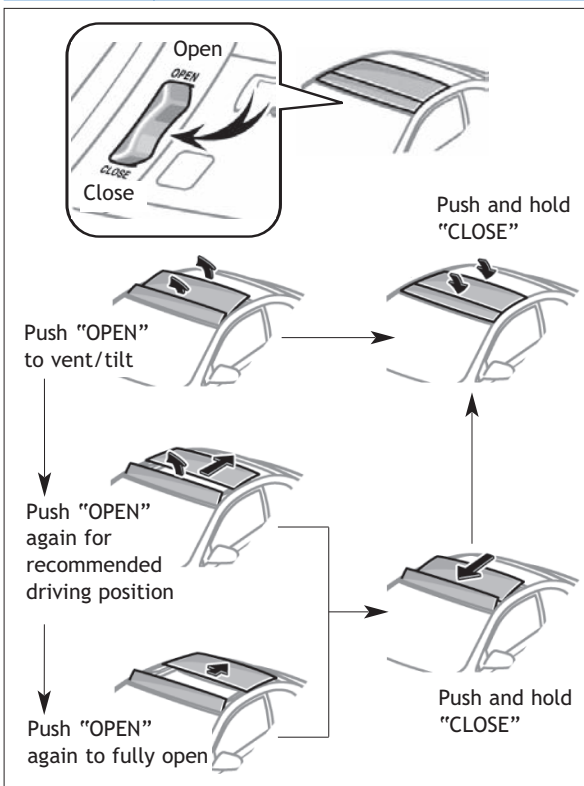

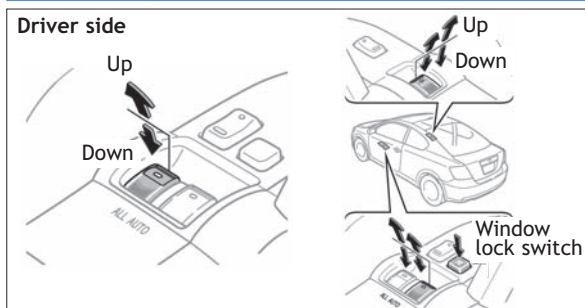


Panorama moonroof (if equipped)

Window operation

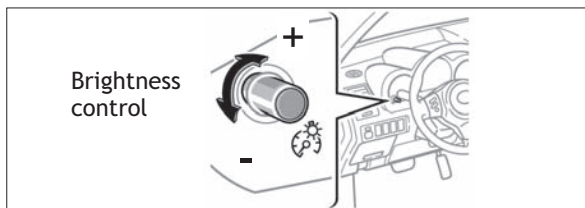
Automatic operation Push the switch completely down or pull* it completely up and release to fully open or close. To stop window mid-way, lightly push the switch in the opposite direction.

Window lock switch Deactivates all passenger windows. Driver's window remains operable.

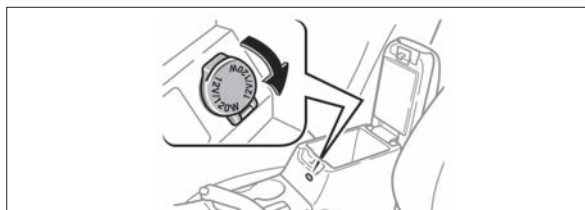




Power outlet (if equipped)

- 8 Temperature

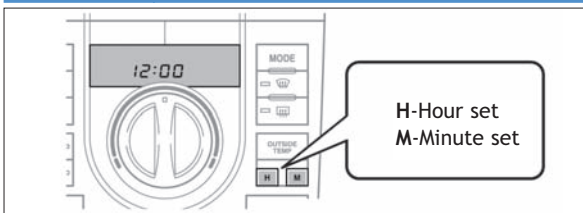
AUX audio jack



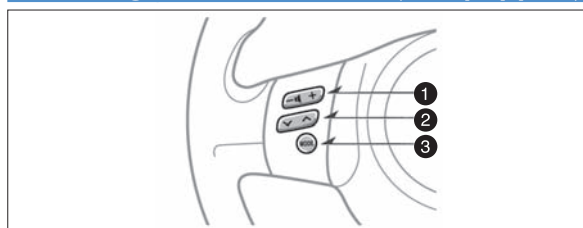
By inserting a mini plug (not included) into the AUX jack, you can listen to music from a portable audio device through the vehicle's speaker system. If you do not have a SCION genuine audio system, you will not be able to use the AUX jack.

Steering wheel switches (if equipped)



- 1 " - + " Volume control
- 2 " v ^ "
 - In radio mode Push to select a preset station; push and hold to seek the next strong station.
 - In CD mode Push to skip up or down to a next/previous track.
- 3 "MODE" Push to turn audio "ON" and select an audio mode. Push and hold to turn audio system "OFF."

iPod jack



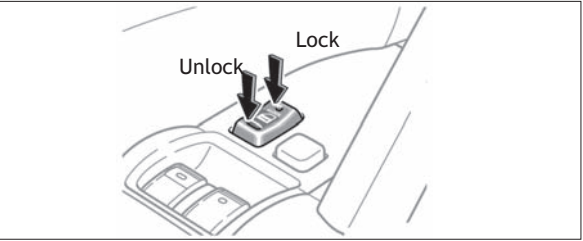
By inserting an iPod customer cable connector into the iPod jack, you can charge the iPod battery and listen to music from your iPod through the vehicle's speaker system.

If you do not have a SCION genuine audio system, you will not be able to use the iPod jack.

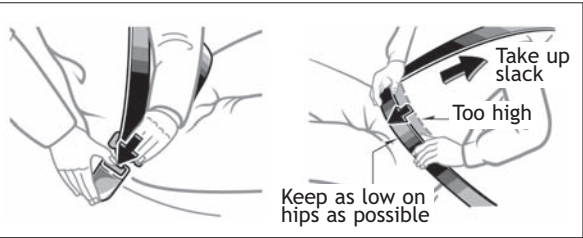

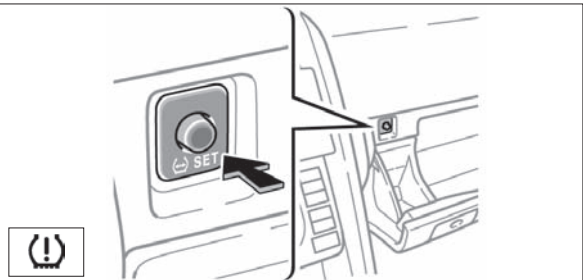
Seat belts



If belt is fully extended, then retracted even slightly, it cannot be re-extended beyond that point, unless fully retracted again. This feature is used to help hold child restraint systems securely.

To find more information about seat belts, and how to install a child restraint system, refer to the *Owner's Manual*.

Tire Pressure Warning System reset

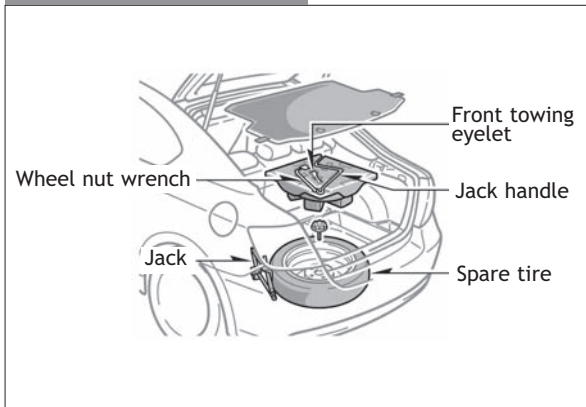


If tire pressure becomes critically low on any of the tires (excluding spare), indicator comes on. Pushing "SET" button should not turn off the light. Correctly adjusting tire inflation will turn off the light after a few minutes. After replacing/rotating tire or wheels, the system must be initialized.

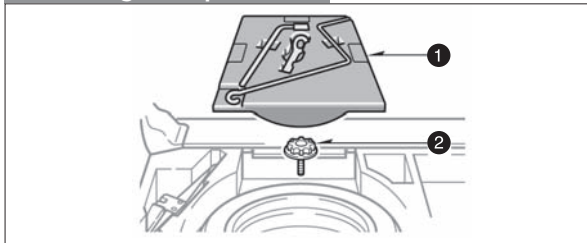
